
OUR FOCUS FOR WORSHIP THIS MORNING

When John the Baptist saw him standing there, he must have done a doubletake. There amongst the tax collectors, Roman soldiers, and other guilty sinners stood Jesus of Nazareth. He was not sinful like they were. He is the Lamb of God who came to take away the sin of the world. So why did he need to be baptized? This question doesn't just trouble us–it troubled John as well. Yet Jesus puts all our troubles in their proper place. He says ^(Mt. 3:14) **It is to fulfill all righteousness.** Jesus did not need to be baptized to cleanse himself of sins. He was baptized to connect himself with sinners and also connect sinners with his righteousness. In Romans 6, Paul speaks of the transformational power found in Baptism. We are connected with Christ and so we cannot return to our old way of living that only resulted in death. Rather we long and we strive to live like our Savior did.

Minister: In the name of the Father and of the Son + and of the Holy Spirit.






- M: I tell you the truth, no one can enter the kingdom of God unless he is born of water and the Spirit.

CONFESSION OF SINS


M: As baptized children of God, we confess our sins.

The Word of God

OLD TESTAMENT READING

49 Listen to me, you islands; hear this, you distant nations: Before I was born the Lord called me: from my mother's womb he has spoken my name. ² He made my mouth like a sharpened sword, in the shadow of his hand he hid me: he made me into a polished arrow and concealed me in his guiver. ³He said to me, "You are my servant, Israel, in whom I will display my splendor." ⁴But I said, "I have labored in vain; I have spent my strength for nothing at all. Yet what is due me is in the Lord's hand, and my reward is with my God." ⁵ And now the Lord sayshe who formed me in the womb to be his servant to bring Jacob back to him and gather Israel to himself, for I am honored in the eyes of the Lord and my God has been my strength-⁶ he says: "It is too small a thing for you to be my servant to restore the tribes of Jacob and bring back those of Israel I have kept. I will also make you a light for the Gentiles, that my salvation may reach to the ends of the earth."



NEW TESTAMENT READING

Romans 6

• What shall we say, then? Shall we go on sinning so that grace may increase? ² By no means! We are those who have died to sin; how can we live in it any longer? ³ Or don't you know that all of us who were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his death? ⁴ We were therefore buried with him through baptism into death in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, we too may live a new life.

⁵ For if we have been united with him in a death like his, we will certainly also be united with him in a resurrection like his. ⁶ For we know that our old self was crucified with him so that the body ruled by sin might be done away with, that we should no longer be slaves to sin–⁷ because anyone who has died has been set free from sin.

NEW TESTAMENT READING

⁸ Now if we died with Christ, we believe that we will also live with him. ⁹ For we know that since Christ was raised from the dead, he cannot die again; death no longer has mastery over him. ¹⁰ The death he died, he died to sin once for all; but the life he lives, he lives to God.

¹¹ In the same way, count yourselves dead to sin but alive to God in Christ Jesus.

GOSPEL READING

⁴ And so John the Baptist appeared in the wilderness, preaching a baptism of repentance for the forgiveness of sins. ⁵ The whole Judean countryside and all the people of Jerusalem went out to him. Confessing their sins, they were baptized by him in the Jordan River. ⁶ John wore clothing made of camel's hair, with a leather belt around his waist, and he ate locusts and wild honey. ⁷ And this was his message: "After me comes the one more powerful than I, the straps of whose sandals I am not worthy to stoop down and untie. ⁸ I baptize you with water, but he will baptize you with the Holy Spirit."

⁹ At that time Jesus came from Nazareth in Galilee and was baptized by John in the Jordan. ¹⁰ Just as Jesus was coming up out of the water, he saw heaven being torn open and the Spirit descending on him like a dove. ¹¹ And a voice came from heaven: "You are my Son, whom I love; with you I am well pleased."



- P: Use us to bring healing to sinners who've hurt themselves and others. Refresh them with a clean conscience towards God and their neighbors.
- M: Heavenly Father, we believe Baptism creates and sustains faith. Yet there are some who have not yet been washed and claimed as yours through Baptism. Listen now to our prayers on their behalf. Move them–and those responsible for them–so that they might be cleansed by water and Word.

A time for silent, personal prayer for those who are not yet baptized.

- M: With the confidence of dearly loved children, we pray as your Son taught:
- P: Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name, your kingdom come, your will be done on earth as in heaven. Give us today our daily bread. Forgive us our sins, as we forgive those who sin against us. Lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. For the kingdom, the power, and the glory are yours now and forever. Amen.


M: Brothers and sisters, go in peace. Live in harmony with one another. Serve the Lord with gladness.
